The Workshops are open to one representative of Community Based Organisations and Non-State Actors who include: non governmental organizations; organisations representing indigenous peoples; organizations representing national and/or ethnic minorities; local traders' associations and citizens' groups; cooperatives; trade unions; organisations representing economic and social interests; organisations fighting corruption and fraud and promoting good governance; civil rights organisations and organisations combating discrimination; local organisations (including networks) involved in decentralized regional cooperation and integration; consumer organizations; women's and youth organizations; teaching, cultural, research and scientific organizations; universities, churches and religious associations and communities; the media and any non-governmental associations and independent foundations, including independent political foundations. The workshops are further open to relevant government officials, local government and parastatal officials and accredited members of the press. CDTF will not pay participants for transport, accommodation and subsistence. Participants are encouraged to attend the workshops at a venue closer to them irrespective of whether the venue falls in their county. Workshops begin at 9:00 a.m.
